

# HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR / COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

## **PURPOSE:**

The 19six Legacy Scholarship is awarded to College or University-bound High School Seniors or Community College Students who demonstrate academic achievement, financial need, and a strong interest in pursuing studies in Architecture, Architectural/Structural Engineering, or Interior Design.

## **ELIGIBLE STUDENT CRITERIA:**

- Must be a 2026 graduating High School Senior or a Community College Student residing in California.
- Must have earned a minimum 3.5 weighted GPA over the past two years.
- Must demonstrate a clear passion for pursuing an education and career in Architecture, Architectural/Structural Engineering, or Interior Design.
- **Must meet one of the following criteria:**
  - Attending a California Community College with a clear pathway to study one of the fields listed above.
  - Accepted into a California University offering an accredited program in one of the fields listed above.

## **AMOUNT:**

### **\$1,500 Scholarship**

The scholarship review panel may award up to five (5) scholarships to eligible High School Seniors and/or Community College Students. Each scholarship is valued at \$1,500 and will be distributed in two installments: \$750 in August 2026 and \$750 in December 2026, subject to verification of continued enrollment.

## **CONSIDERATIONS:**

Consideration will be given to applicants' academic achievements, financial need, community service involvement, and demonstrated passion for pursuing Architecture, Architectural/Structural Engineering, or Interior Design.
