

# UNIVERSITY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

## **PURPOSE:**

The 19six Legacy Scholarship provides financial support to students pursuing studies in Architecture, Architectural/Structural Engineering, or Interior Design. Applicants should demonstrate strong academic performance, a genuine passion for their field, financial need, and clear post-graduation goals.

Scholarship recipients will participate in an eight-week collaborative paid internship at a mutually agreed-upon office location, subject to office needs and capacity.

## **ELIGIBLE STUDENT CRITERIA:**

- Currently attending a UC, CSU, or Private California University.
- Architecture students must be in their 3rd or 4th year and entering their 4th or 5th year of the program.
- Architectural/Structural Engineering and Interior Design students must be in their 3rd year and entering their 4th year of the program.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

## **AMOUNT:**

### **\$2,000 Scholarship**

The review panel may award up to three (3) scholarships.

Scholarships will be disbursed in two installments: \$1,000 in August 2026 and \$1,000 in December 2026.

## **CONSIDERATIONS:**

Consideration will be given to applicants' academic achievements, passion for their design discipline, financial need, and post-graduation aspirations within the fields of Architecture, Architectural/Structural Engineering, or Interior Design.
